

Mass of the Resurrection Easter Sunday - April 9, 2023

Readings for next week: 1 Peter 1:3-9

Acts 2:42-47

John 20:19-31

FOCUS: This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad.

Today's readings describe the effects of Jesus' resurrection on those who walked with him, and also what the resurrection has accomplished for us. In Acts, Peter testifies that belief in the risen Lord leads to the forgiveness of sins. Saint Paul tells the Colossians that our death and life in Jesus will result in our glorification. Everything that Jesus did, he did for us.



Divine Mercy Sunday

Divine Mercy Sunday is celebrated on the week after Easter, which is next week Sunday, April 16th. Pope John Paul II granted plenary and partial indulgences if the faithful will observe certain pious practices on Divine Mercy Sunday. In order to receive the indulgence, one must go to confession, receive Holy Communion, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father. One must also take part in the devotion of the Divine Mercy by praying the chaplet or Adoration of the Blessed

Sacrament. While it is appropriate for the Sacraments to be received on the same day, the Church permits them to be received up to 20 days before or after the indulgenced work is performed.

For the sick or others who can't make it to church on that day, a plenary indulgence may still be obtained. One must intend to make confession, receive Holy Communion, and pray for the Holy Father as soon as possible, while praying one Our Father, the Nicene Creed before the image of Jesus, and a "devout invocation" to Christ such as "Merciful Jesus. I trust in You."

Christian Life Program - Couples for Christ Ministry

The Christian Life Program is an integrated course intended to lead the program participants into a renewed understanding of God's call to them as Christian couples or individuals.
