



Saints of the Week




St. Vincent de Paul - He was a French Catholic priest, who dedicated himself to serving the poor. He co-founded the Vincentians & also founded the Daughters of Charity of St. Vincent de Paul. He is renowned for his compassion, humility, & generosity. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul, which is a charitable organization that serves the poor, is present today in 153 countries. He's the patron saint of charities, volunteers, & horses. His feast day is Sept. 27th.



The 3 Archangels, Sts. Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, were grouped together after Vatican II on one feast day, September 29th. Each one had a specific mission in salvation history and continue their protective help in the world.



St. Michael, whose name means "Who is like God," was the leader of all the angels & the army of God. He symbolizes the victory of good over evil. He's been revered as the protector of the church & known as the "Prince of the Heavenly Host." He's the patron saint of grocers, soldiers, doctors, mariners, first responders, & police.





St. Raphael, whose name means "God heals," helps with healing & protecting humans & with those on journeys. His main role is healer of mind, body, & spirit. He's credited with driving the evil spirit from Sarah & restoring Tobit's vision. He's the patron saint of travelers, medical workers, & ill people.
