

<u>FOCUS</u>: Through Christ we are made righteous and have eternal life.

On this first Sunday of Lent, our readings bring into focus the great drama of our salvation history: Our first parents sinned, and through them death came to all. Yet our gracious God sent his Son not to condemn but to free us and show his power over Satan. Through him we are made righteous.

## Lenten Regulations for the Diocese of Honolulu (cont.)

#### **BLESSING OF THE OILS AND CONSECRATION OF THE CHRISM**

In order to allow participation of Catholics throughout the islands, the Sacred Oils will be blessed during the Chrism Mass to be celebrated in several locations.

The Chrism Mass for Oahu-Molokai will be held on: Tue., April 4th at 7 p.m., Co-Cathedral of St. Theresa, Hon.

#### THE SACRED PASCHAL TRIDUUM

"Since Christ accomplished his work of human redemption and of the perfect glorification of God principally through his Paschal Mystery, in which by dying he has destroyed our death, and by rising restored our life, the sacred Paschal Triduum of the Passion and Resurrection of the Lord shines forth as the high point of the entire liturgical year" (Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and the Calendar, #18).

Three major liturgical principles may be of help here:

a. The Triduum may be viewed as a single liturgical action that occurs over a period of three days.

b. The Triduum is not part of Lent, but in its entirety, celebrates the Easter event.

c. The entire focus of the Triduum is on the Triumph of the Cross and the Resurrection.

Bishop Larry will be here at our parish next weekend, **March 4<sup>th</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> for an Episcopal Visit.** 


On Sat. Mar. 4<sup>th</sup> the Bishop will preside over the 5 p.m.
