

To qualify, you must:

- Be a current lawful permanent resident (green card holder for 5 years or 3 years if married to a U.S. Citizen or you are a U.S. National residing in Hawaii for more than 3 months
- Show good moral character
- Pass a reading, writing, and civics exam or qualify for an exemption
