

150th Anniversary of Fr. Damien's arrival in Kalaupapa


The annual Memorial of St. Damien is May 10, which is the anniversary of the date of his arrival in Kalaupapa.



The Christian Life Program is an integrated course intended to lead the program participants into a renewed understanding of God's call to them as Christian couples or individuals.
