What is Divine Mercy Sunday?

Pope John Paul II declared Sr. Faustina Kowalska a saint of the Church on April 30, 2000, and in a decree dated May 23, 2000, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments stated that "throughout the world the Second Sunday of Easter will receive the name Divine Mercy Sunday, a perennial invitation to the Christian world to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that [we] will experience in the years to come."

Saint Faustina was born in 1905 and spent most of her life in Poland, in the Congregation of the Virgin Mary of Mercy. She experienced an extraordinary union with God. She received exceptional graces, revelations, visions, hidden stigmata, the ability to read souls, and the gift of prophecy.

One of the images that was revealed to Faustina was that of the merciful Jesus, touching his Sacred Heart, from which beams of red and white light came forth. This image and her devotion to the divine mercies gathered thousands of supporters throughout the world. We still see the traditional image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in many of our churches today. In some churches, we might see the newer image, inspired by the saint. Saint Faustina Kowalska died in 1938 at the age of thirty-three, leaving an impressive mystical legacy. She is a disciple of God's divine mercy for the twenty-first century. • *The Redemptorists / DearPadre.org*

Feasts of the Week

Feast of the Annunciation of the Lord - Feast Day is April 8th. Usually celebrated on March 25th each year, in 2024 it's being observed on April 8th due to the customary date being Holy Monday. This feast commemorates the Archangel Gabriel's visit to the Blessed Virgin Mary, during which he announced to her that she was chosen to be the mother of Jesus, the Son of God and our Savior. It's a major Marian feast and considered a Solemnity in the Catholic Church. It is also one of the 8 great feasts of the Lord, since it announces his Incarnation with Mary's obedient affirmative response to Archangel Gabriel. This special feast shows us the great things that God

can bring when we cooperate with him. We also learn from Mary what it means to have faith in God and can believe that God would do what he has promised.
